MAHC Supports Closing Constitutional Loopholes

Missourians Against Human Cloning (MAHC) enthusiastically supports the Senate and House Joint Resolutions announced today by Sen. Matt Bartle (R-Lee's Summit) and Rep. Jim Lembke (R-St. Louis), to provide a genuine ban on human cloning.

“While the proponents of human cloning research have used deceptive and complicated language to mislead voters, the Bartle/Lembke resolution will very clearly ban all human cloning. We know that Missourians do not want to constitutionally protect human cloning, nor do they want their tax dollars to pay for it,” states Jaci Winship, Executive Director of MAHC.

Today's press conference in St. Louis, which was held at the MAHC headquarters, drew over one hundred supporters who asked questions and applauded the legislators for their leadership on this critical issue. Sen. Bartle and Rep. Lembke held other press conferences today in Jefferson City, Cape Girardeau, Springfield and Kansas City.

“We know that once Missourians understand that loopholes in our current state constitution actually protect human cloning, they will support honest legislation to close those loopholes,” said Winship.
